Subject: Play In Games Rules/Procedures Check -in Overtime

Dear Referees/Coaches/Clubs:

Thank you for registering for the Play in Games to qualify for the Fall 2025 State Cup 15-19U Boys.

Each game is single elimination and must have a winner.

Referees paid at the field by the teams- go to scyouthsoccer.com under Competitions and Referee fees for NLSC rates.

Check in documents- **Physical** game/tournament/league (Piedmont/NLSC) **roster** and **physical player cards**. Referee will need a physical card to count substitutions. Make sure you get the cards back at the end of the match.

Substitutions – Unlimited over four (4) moments* **per match + halftime**

Maximum players permitted to enter the game – 18 players.

If you play the game then you except the results. Do not cry foul after the game- take time to address any roster or player issues before kickoff. My cell is 803-600-0064

Over time period is two 15 minutes periods. No Golden goal.

If OT period ends without a winner then kicks from the mark with players on the field at the end of the OT period only.

OT period is treated as a single half so limited substitutions and no re-entry for the entire OT period (30 minutes) under NCS Rules Section 3 below

(2) for all other age groups (15-19U), a maximum of 7 substitutions for each Team shall be allowed in each game during each half of play and during overtime play. After leaving the game during a half of play, the substituted player may not re-enter the game during the same half of play. After leaving the game during overtime play, the substituted player may not re-enter the game.

Once the game is decided then send score to Leagues@scysa.org.

If you win then please register for the State Cup as soon as possible. Piedmont teams do have a fee for State Cup registration. NLSC do not have a fee since event covered by your league fee.
